Social Justice Statement 2023-2024

On this Social Justice Sunday, Australia's Bishops are asking us to renew our engagement with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples.

In their Social Justice Statement, *Listen, Learn, Love: A New Engagement with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples*, they join with the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholic Council (NATSICC) to call on us to develop relationships of humility and love with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples.

The statement tells us about the painful experiences of many First Nations people. It is very challenging reading in parts.

We are followers of Christ whose central message is that love is the way. Prominent Aboriginal lawyer, Noel Pearson, is quoted in the statement as saying that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people feel unloved. How difficult must that be? We can't just turn a blind eye to this.

We are going to vote in the Voice referendum before the end of the year. NATSICC supports a Yes vote, but the Bishops will not tell us how to vote. However, they do urge us to inform ourselves about the issues and to engage in respectful dialogue about the issues, especially with First Nations People. This is one moment when we can try harder to listen to First Nations People and learn from them about their experiences and hopes.

The referendum is an important moment in our history. Just as important is what happens in the months and years following. As the Bishops and NATSICC say, we, in the Church, can model how Jesus' way of love can make a difference.

On this Social Justice Sunday, let's commit ourselves to reaching out to First Nations people in love and humility. Let's try to listen to them and learn from them and walk the journey of healing together – first in relation to the referendum and, then, in the period that follows. 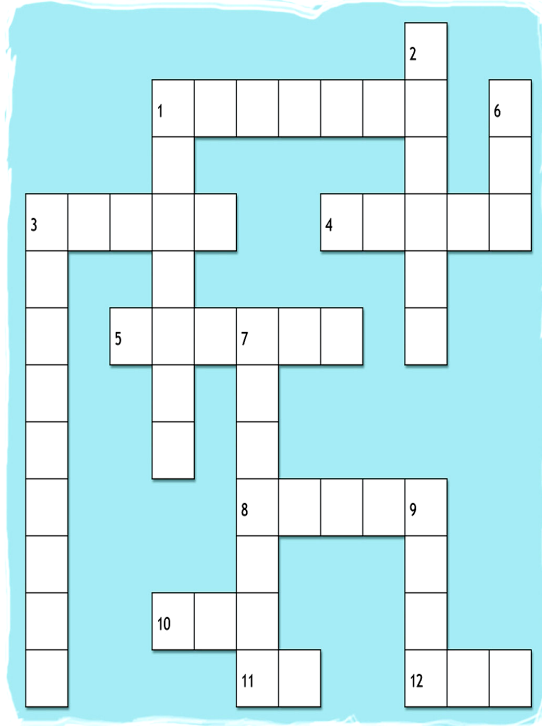

Scam Alert – Phishing Messages and Emails

It has come to our attention that our parishioners have been **receiving text messages and emails impersonating staff and or priests** asking for help in the form of money or gift cards. Do not reply or click on any links and block the email or phone number. These emails and messages are designed to look legitimate from trusted sources, but they are actually attempts to steal personal information or infect your device with malware. To stay safe, it is important to remain vigilant and follow best practices for online security.



- Check the sender's email address or phone number
- Be cautious of urgent or threatening language in messages as well as the request of sensitive information
- Avoid clicking links or downloading attachments from unknown or suspicious sources

Carpark Fundraising at Sacred Heart Church

Dear Parishioners,

Our Parish Pastoral Council consists of members from our Mass and School communities. We generally meet every 6 weeks. Below are some key points from our Pastoral Plan that we have worked on this year. The items listed below are key ones being focused on at present.

Parish Pastoral Plan items

- Introduce 2023 Social Justice Statement on Social Justice Sunday 27th Aug
- Create awareness of *Laudate Si* document and its messages through Creation Month (September) and gradually explore ways to apply this in our parish context.
- Continue the formation of Lectors (Readers) and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion
- APRIMs & Preca leaders to review the Sacramental Program during 2023
- Introduce/consolidate the Welcoming & Hospitality Ministry
- A PPC report to be provided to both Mass and School communities following each meeting
- Ongoing invitation to school communities to be involved in Parish Masses one Sunday a month.
- Establish a Parish calendar reflecting liturgical, social and educational activities across the parish

SHC Community Centre building plans

- Due to finances, plans need to be staged over time.
- Stage 1 negotiations occurring: create Parish Office space on ground floor and space for commercial offices upstairs; new toilets and lift.
- Stage 2 deferred: Community centre and outdoor area/ carpark at rear of Offices
- Safeguarding: ensuring all Volunteers have Working with Children checks for the safety of our community.

Fundraising Committee report

- Car Parking at SHC for the soccer matches has been a great fundraiser.
- Parish Dinner was attended by close to 300 people. Approximately \$6800 was raised.
- Other fundraisers/community events are being explored.

A Centenary planning committee to be set up.

Schools / Parish Groups

- Much is happening in our schools; reports are provided.
- Vinnies are in need of food items: schools to redirect their collections to our parish branch.
