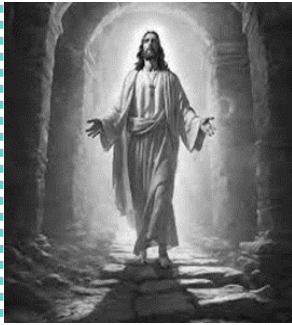

## The Resurrection of Christ

### The Resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian Faith.

For it proves that Jesus is God. That is why St. Paul writes: *"If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your Faith is in vain... And if Christ has not been raised, then your Faith is a delusion, and you are still lost in your sins... But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep"* (1 Cor 15:14, 17, 20). In the words of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC #638): *"The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our Faith in Christ, a Faith believed and lived as the central truth by the first Christian community; handed on as fundamental by Tradition; established by the documents of the New Testament; and preached as an essential part of the Paschal mystery along with the cross..."* If Jesus Christ did not rise from the dead, then the Church is a fraud and Faith is a sham. But if Jesus really did rise from the dead, his message is true! Without the Resurrection, Jesus would have remained forever a good person who had met a tragic end. People would remember some of his teachings, and a handful of people might try to live according to them. All the basic doctrines of Christianity are founded on the truth of the Resurrection.

*"Jesus is Lord; He is risen!"* (Rom 10:9) was the central theme of the *kerygma* (or "preaching"), of the apostles. There is a story of two women who stood before Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris. One asked, *"Why can't we build structures like this anymore?"* Her friend answered, *"*

*The people who built this had Faith. Today we have only opinions. And you can't build a cathedral with opinions."*

## Our own Resurrection

### Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection.

Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: *"I am the Resurrection and the Life; whoever believes in Me will live even though he die"* (Jn 11:25-26).

Christ will raise us up on the last day, but it is also true, in a sense, that we have already risen with Christ. By virtue of the Holy Spirit, our Christian life is already a participation in the death and Resurrection of Christ (CCC #1002, #1003).

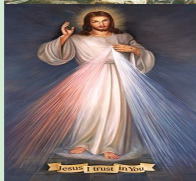
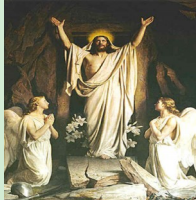

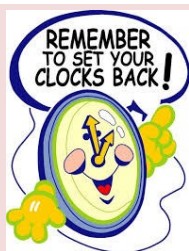
